

## Operational Policy 04: LARGE ITEM & HAZARDOUS WASTE DISPOSAL

Date Adopted by Board: 4-10-18

**Policy Statement:** Disposal of large items and appliances in Lakeshore Village (LSV) must be done according to established procedures.

## **Procedures:**

- A. Large items such as water heaters, stoves, refrigerators, doors, etc. can be disposed of by placement at the end of Laketower Drive (543 entrance) on the left side of the dumpster for curbside collection by Lexington's Waste Management.
- B. Carpet and padding must be hauled away by installers.
- C. Curbside collection is not available for the following items and therefore should not be placed at the end of Laketower: TV's, computers, printers, humidifiers and microwaves. Such electronic items should be taken to the city's electronic recycling center.
- D. Christmas trees must be disposed of at the end of Laketower Drive.
- E. Large items must not be placed into the dumpsters or in any other area in LSV.
- F. Hazardous waste and dangerous items such as glass, paint, fertilizer, etc. should not be placed in or around dumpsters and will not be picked up by Waste Management. Questions about proper disposal of such items can be directed to LSV management and the city's Waste Management Division.
